Dr Leong Kam Kei is the Assistant Director of the Student Health Centre at Health Promotion Board (HPB). The Student Health Centre (SHC) is a referral centre which sees and manages medical conditions of students. The SHC has general clinics, nutrition clinics and immunisation clinics, and also refraction and audiometry services and attends to students referred by the School Health Service (SHS) teams which conduct health screening examinations and immunisations for students during annual visits to schools.

Dr Leong has good understanding of medical conditions in students and is familiar with the school health screening and immunisation programmes, and conducts talks on various health topics for HPB programmes and activities.
